



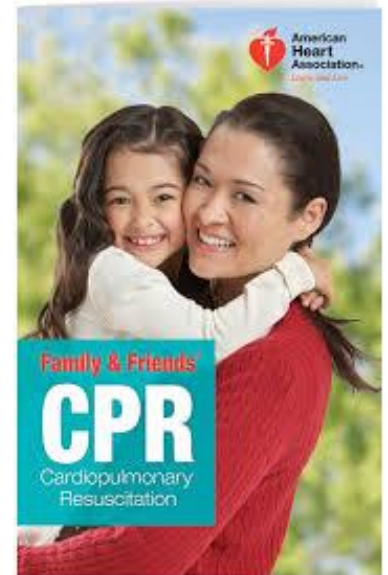
PINE HILL POLICE DEPARTMENT HOSTING FREE COMMUNITY CPR TRAINING

The Pine Hill Police Department will be hosting free CPR training, open to all members of the Pine Hill community who are 18 years old or older. Pine Hill Police Officers who are certified EMTs and American Heart Association CPR Instructors will provide American Heart Association Family & Friends CPR instruction and course material during the 3 hour training sessions.

Family & Friends CPR is for people who want to learn CPR but do not need a course completion card in CPR for their job. This course is ideal for, parents, grandparents, babysitters and others interested in learning how to save a life.

The Family & Friends CPR Course teaches the lifesaving skills of adult Hands-Only® CPR, child CPR with breaths, adult and child AED use, infant CPR and relief of choking in an adult, child or infant. Skills are taught in a dynamic group environment by using the AHA's research-proven practice-while-watching technique, which provides students with the most hands-on CPR practice time possible.

Each student will receive an AHA Family & Friends CPR Student Manual, which also contains a tear-out course completion card and a Certificate of Completion issued by the Pine Hill Police Department.



Four initial sessions have been scheduled to accommodate work hours, family activities and the upcoming youth spring sport events. Participants must attend only 1 session. Sessions are limited to 15 participants. Training locations will be within the Borough of Pine Hill and confirmed via email prior to the scheduled date of training. Additional sessions will be scheduled based on the response by community members.
