## High School Teacher Arrested

Camden County Prosecutor Warren W. Faulk and Pine Hill Police Chief Chris Winters reported a teacher at Overbrook High School has been charged with having inappropriate relations with a student.

Daniel Poussart, M/28, of Pine Hill, is charged with Official Misconduct, Sexual Assault, Criminal Sexual Contact and Endangering the Welfare of a Child. He was arrested this morning and is being held at the Camden County Jail on \$450,000 bail.

It is alleged Poussart, a music teacher, engaged in sexual acts with a female student from November to December 2013 while in a supervisory relationship to the victim.

Poussart has been suspended with pay at this time and will be suspended without pay should he be indicted on these charges. The Pine Hill School District offered full assistance to law enforcement in the investigation of this matter.
